- Grade III** **Event 4** 2/4 March - 4 parts
- Event 5** Strathspey and Reel
- Grade II** **Event 6** MSR - Submit 2
- Event 7** Hornpipe and Jig

Awards are trophies and/or medals for the first three places. They are very cool!

Ensemble Piping Rules: Pipes only, minimum 3. 3-5 minutes long. Emphasis on entertainment. Traditional Pipe Band Medleys and MSR discouraged but accepted. Traditional or contemporary music accepted. Can be 1 or several tunes.
