## *10+ Ways for Solo Competitors to Get Along With Contest Organizers:*

### 10+ Ways for Solo Competitors to Get Along With Contest Organizers:

1. Submit your solo entry form in a timely manner. Waiting until after the deadline makes it difficult for the organizer to set up times and judges. Especially in Grade 4 Solo Events, there could be large fields already entered by the cutoff date and no room for more.
2. Clearly print all information requested. Difficult to read handwriting requires time to figure out what the form says or tracking down correct information. Please have your name and return address on the outside of your mailing envelope. Contest Organizers often keep this until after the competitions are done and need to be able to find specific envelopes if necessary.
3. Enclose a stamped, self addressed size 10 business envelope, even if the form does not request it and make sure your mailing address is clearly written. This does help cutting down the time and costs involved in sending your contest information.
4. If family members or friends wish pre-sale tickets, please use the proper form and mail to the correct address. Contest Organizers often have only enough tickets for their needs and these tickets may be a specific type just for competitors.
5. Do not ask for special favors or considerations unless absolutely necessary and do not be upset if the request cannot be granted. Contest Organizers do wish to assist when possible, but time and circumstances may not allow for much variance from what has already been established.
6. Please show up early, at least ½ hour, before your first event and check in at the proper station to do so. Make sure you understand the directions given and if there are stewards for these events make sure you check in with them as well. Know which platforms you are to be competing at.
7. Make sure you tune up or practice away from the ongoing competitions and check with stewards on the timeliness of your events. Make sure the steward knows how to quickly locate you when it is your turn. If asked to play out of turn, please take into consideration that they are trying to keep the competition moving along.
8. Mistakes can happen and often do in the very busy first few hours of any competition. Please try to be understanding about errors and work with the Contest Organizers in correcting the problem. Everyone involved is a volunteer and doing the best they can. Please respect them in times of adversity and keep the number of people involved to an absolute minimum. If you are not fully satisfied with the resolution, you have a right to submit a proper protest to WUSPBA for clarification of the rules.
9. Leave Contest Organizers to their tasks at hand, especially the contest tally, as constantly interrupting them may delay their work. While the results are now easier to calculate under the Solo Competition Rules, they still need to be checked before posting.
10. When the results are posted, please follow directions for receiving any medals or awards. Show up for any awards ceremonies in a timely manner and pay attention for your

attention and will pay off once the competition/parade/job season hits and there's less time for this sort of instruction.

It's also a great time for the Executive Committee to review the year and plan for the next one. Normally in January we'd be hustling to get the AGM in order, but that is well behind us now - nothing but smooth sailing ahead (we hope!) November's AGM was well attended (thank you all) and, as Andrew has stated, well run in that we were able to complete our business meeting in record time and turn our attention to the four guest instructors. The Saturday evening ceilidh was a delight - seems like there should always be piping and drumming at these events. While the sessions I attended

were well done and most helpful, it was discouraging to be one of less than a half dozen attendees. I am hoping if we bring comparable instruction to the AGM each year we can increase the number of pipers and drummers who make the trip to Vegas to take advantage of these offerings. I frequently hear lamenting that the midsections - bass and tenor - are overlooked. Tenors and bass drummers had the opportunity to be completely the object of Davey McAdam's attention this year, yet he had few students. Is it worth doing again? I need feedback from you to indicate whether to pursue such workshops. I know the handful of snare drummers in Duncan Millar's classes, from beginners to pros, were exhausted and energized when he was through with them (the drumming lasted on into the night at the ceilidh...)

The point is the money that brings these teachers to the AGM is your money, spent in the fond hopes of improving outreach to as many WUSPBA members as possible. We'll give the sessions if you will come! And I would once again encourage bands to reach into their treasuries to help offset travel costs for members willing to attend, learn, and report back to their corps.

I am easily reached and am already looking at possible instructors for November's AGM. It would help if those who attended gave me and others their feedback on the weekend so we can 'drum up business' instead of 'piping down'...

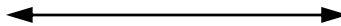
